The **Johari Window** is a simple and useful tool for understanding and exercising self-awareness, personal development, improving communications, interpersonal relationships, group dynamics, team development and intergroup relationships.

It represents information-feelings, experience, views, attitudes, skills, intentions, motivation, etc- within or about a person - in relation to their team, from four perspectives:

- 1.... **Open area**, open self, free area, free self, or 'the area ': what is known by the person about him/herself and is also known by others –
- 2.... **Blind area**, blind self, or 'blind spot ': what is unknown by the person about him/herself but which others know
- 3.... **Hidden area**, hidden self, avoided area, avoided self or 'façade': what the person knows about him/herself that others do not know
- 4.... **Unknown area** or unknown self: what is unknown by the person about him/herself and is also unknown by others



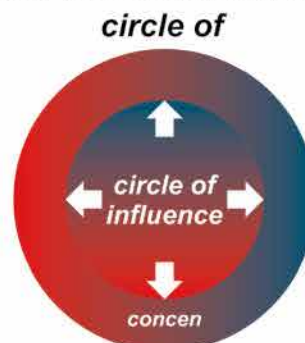
- The open region expands because others know a lot about the person that the person also knows.
- Through the processes of disclosure and receiving feedback the open area has expanded and at the same time reduced the sizes of the hidden, blind and unknown areas.

The Circles of Concern and Influence

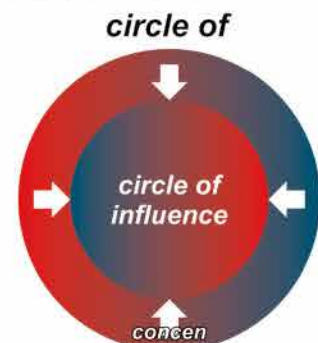

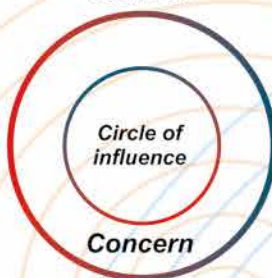

Concern**

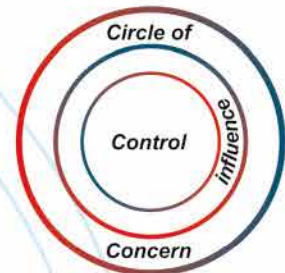
The “Circle of Concern” includes the wide range of concerns you have in the world, your work and life – including health, family, finances, the economy, national debt etc. Everything you include inside the circle is a concern and matters to you and everything outside the circle is of little or no concern to you.

Your Circle of Influence are the things that concern you that you can do something about. For example – you may be worried about the economy or climate change or coronavirus (i.e. circle of concern), however what can you do about it (i.e. your circle of influence)

There are 2 levels of Influence Direct, the Circle of Control and Indirect, the Circle of Influence, so its clearer to articulate the power of choice.

Motivation

Motivation is described as a state that energizes, directs and sustains behavior. Motivation involves goals and requires activity. Goals provide the impetus for and the direction of action, while action entails effort: persistence in order to sustain an activity for a long period of time. The selection of a task under free-choice conditions indicates the motivation to perform the task. High effort levels, especially when working on different tasks and assignments, are also indicative of motivation. For example, if a student diligently works on a difficult algebra problem again and again, this would indicate a higher level of motivation towards math activities.

Finally, level of achievement is affected by choice, effort and persistence. The higher these indices, the higher the motivation and the more likely task achievement will occur.

In the classroom, educators should be aware of these indices in an effort to reinforce activities and interests that students already show an existing partiality for. There is an actual term for this-it's called situational motivation.

Situational motivation is a phenomenon in which aspects of the immediate environment enhance motivation to learn particular things or behave in particular

ways. Educators can do many things to create a classroom environment that motivates students to learn and behave in ways that promote their long-term success.

"How Motivation Affects Learning & Behavior"

Motivation has several effects on students' learning and behavior.

First, motivation directs behavior toward particular goals. Motivation determines the specific goals toward which people strive; thus, it affects the choices students make. For example, whether to enroll in an art class or physics, whether to attend a school basketball game during the week or complete an assignment that's due the next day.

Motivation also leads to increased effort and energy. Motivation determines whether a student will pursue a task (even a difficult one) with enthusiasm or a lackluster attitude.

Motivation increases the initiation and persistence of activities. Student motivation both typically and naturally has to do with the student's desire to participate in the learning process. Motivation reflects the reasons or goals that underlie their involvement or non-involvement in academic activities.

A student who is intrinsically motivated undertakes an activity "for its own sake, for the enjoyment it provides, the learning it permits, or the feelings of accomplishment it evokes" (Lepper, 1988, p. 290).

Goal Orientation Motivation derives from a variety of forces. It is dynamic, highly subject to change, and a major factor in readiness and desire to learn. Students choose to exert a specific type and level of effort, and their reasons are as diverse as their attitudes and abilities. Students may be equally motivated to perform a task, yet the sources of their motivation may differ. Teachers must recognize, monitor, and attempt to influence those factors that motivate students. Communication such as giving feedback on performance constitutes a prime opportunity either to enhance motivation or decimate it. Receiving feedback or a grade on performance creates a high-stakes situation for students, for they take it very personally, and not only in the academic sense. Their self-esteem and self-efficacy are affected; they either find themselves on solid footing or in quicksand. Therefore, the manner in which feedback is delivered, is of paramount importance.

In the same manner Mc Murry once said. "I believe that motivation is the most important principle in education." Thorndike makes the same point in explaining that "thought and action occur largely in the service of wants, interest, and attitudes and are stimulated and guided by them."

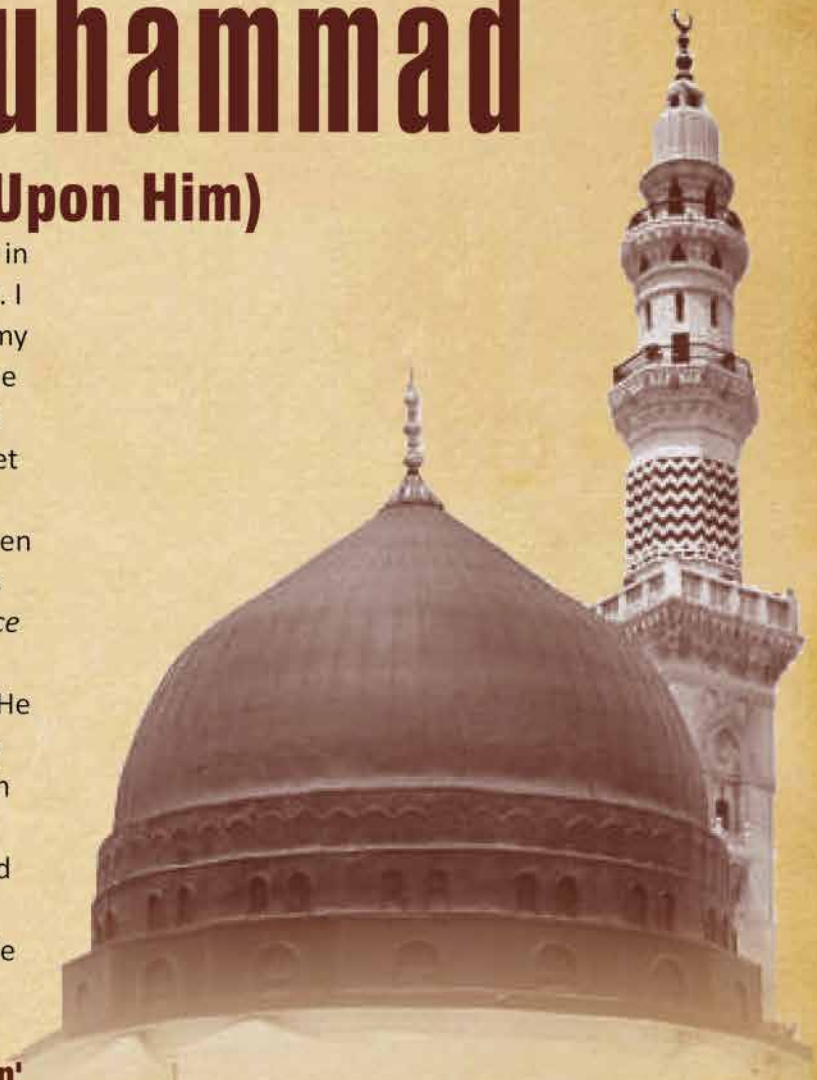

Our beloved Prophet *Peace Be Upon Him* said,

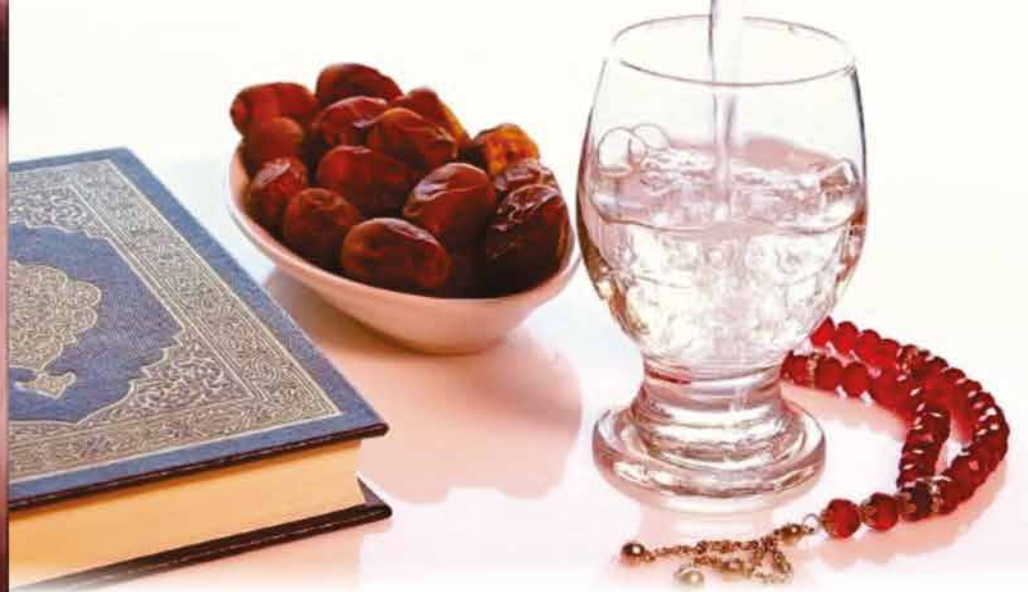
“Salah is The Miraj for A Muslim”

On that time he realized that where my greed has brought me but it was too late. From that day onward Arthur lived in a small hut and sell garbage to get money for food.

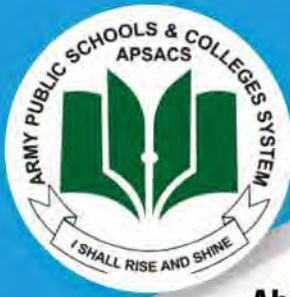

ایک دفعہ کا ذکر ہے۔ کہ کسی ملک میں ایک دولت مند شخص رہتا تھا۔ اللہ تعالیٰ نے اسے تین بیٹے عطا کیے۔ اس نے سوچا کہ موت برحق ہے۔ آخر مجھے ایک دن مرنا ہے۔ کیوں نہ اپنی تمام دولت تینوں بیٹوں میں تقسیم کر دوں۔ اس نے ایسا ہی کیا اور اپنی تمام دولت کو تینوں بیٹوں میں تقسیم کرتے ہوئے کہا یہ ایک قیمتی لعل ہے اور یہ قیمتی موتی اس خوش نصیب کو ملے گا جس نے زندگی میں کوئی اچھا کام کیا ہوگا۔ سب سے بڑے بیٹے نے اس وقت بتایا کہ ایک دفعہ میرے ایک واقف کار نے اشرفیوں سے بھری ایک تھیلی بطور امانت میرے حوالے کی جو میں نے اسی طرح کچھ خیانت کیے بغیر لوٹا دی۔ دوسرے بیٹے نے اپنی بھی زندگی کا اہم واقعہ سنایا کہ ایک دفعہ میں دریا کے کنارے جا رہا تھا کہ کیا دیکھتا ہوں کہ ایک ماں سے اس کا چھوٹا سا بیٹا اچھلا اور دریا میں جا گرا۔ ممتا تڑپ اٹھی میں نے اس ماں کی یہ حالت دیکھی تو فوراً دریا میں چھلانگ لگا دی۔ تیز طوفانی موجوں سے بچے کو نکال لایا اور ماں کے حوالے کیا کہ ماں بہت خوش ہوئی اور مجھے ڈھیروں دعائیں دیتی چلی گئی۔ سب سے چھوٹے بیٹے نے اپنی زندگی کا اہم واقعہ اس طرح سنایا کہ ایک دفعہ آدھی رات کا وقت تھا آسمان پر گہرے بادل چھائے ہوئے تھے بجلی چمک رہی تھی کہ اچانک میری نظر پہاڑ کے دامن میں ایک غار کے کنارے پڑے ہوئے بے ہوش آدمی پر پڑی جو موت کے منہ میں بے ہوش پڑا ہوا تھا۔ میں نے قریب جا کر دیکھا تو وہ میرا ہی دشمن تھا۔ اس وقت میں اس سے بڑی ہی آسانی سے انتقام لے سکتا تھا مگر میرے ضمیر نے یہ بات گوارہ نہ کی کیونکہ مردہ دشمن کو مارنا کوئی بہادری نہیں۔ میں اسے اٹھا کر گھر لایا۔ اُسے ہوش میں لانے کے بعد کھانے پینے کو دیا اور اسے موت کے منہ سے بچایا۔ مزید یہ کہ میں نے اس خیال سے اپنا منہ چھپا لیا کہیں وہ شرمندہ نہ ہو۔ باپ نے تینوں بیٹوں کی کہانی سنی تو چھوٹے بیٹے کو اٹھ کر سینے سے لگایا اور کہا کہ تمہارا کام واقعی جواں مردی کا ہے۔ یہ کہہ کر لعل اس کے حوالے کر دیا کہ تم نے حقوق العباد کا پاس کیا جو خدا کو بہت پسند ہے۔

اس کہانی سے ہمیں یہ اخلاقی سبق ملتا ہے۔ کہ ”مصیبت میں دوسروں کے کام آنا جواں مردی ہے“ اور ”مصیبت میں حقوق العباد کی پہچان ہوتی ہے“ اور ”دوست وہ جو مصیبت میں کام آئے“۔

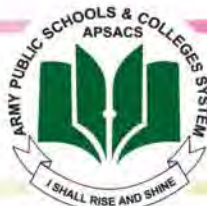

کے سامنے نہ کریں۔ تیسری بات رات بچوں کو جلدی سُلانے کی عادت ڈالیں تاکہ صبح وہ تروتازہ اسکول آسکیں۔ چوتھی بات بچوں کے دوست و احباب پر نظر رکھیں اور کوشش کریں کہ ان کو بُری سوسائٹی سے بچائیں۔

پانچویں اور آخری بات آج جبکہ انٹرنیٹ اور موبائل جہاں تعلیمی معیار میں ایک اہم کردار ادا کر رہے ہیں وہاں انکے منفی رول کو نظر انداز نہیں کیا جاسکتا لہذا ضرورت ہے کہ سب بچے آپ کے سامنے رہیں آج کے حالات میں یہ بہت ضروری ہے۔

2- اساتذہ کے کردار کو کسی بھی ضرورت میں نظر انداز نہیں کیا جاسکتا۔ خوش نصیب ہیں وہ طلباء و طالبات جن کو اچھے اور قابل اساتذہ میسر آئے اور انھوں نے معاشرے میں ایک اہم کردار

1- والدین بچے کی پیدائش سے آغاز سے سب سے پہلے ذمہ داری ان پر عائد ہوتی ہے۔ بد قسمتی سے اکثر بچوں کو وہ ماحول میسر نہیں آتا جو ابتدائی طور پر ضروری ہوتا ہے۔ ماں اور باپ کے اختلافات یا والدین کا معاشی طور پر کمزور ہونا اور پھر روزگار کے حصول کے لیے پردیس میں جانا اور بچے والدین کی توجہ نہ ملنے سے چڑچڑے ہو جاتے ہیں۔ اکثر بچے صبح بغیر ناشتہ کے اسکول آتے ہیں اور خالی پیٹ نہ صرف ان کی نشوونما اثر انداز ہوتی ہے بلکہ وہ صحیح معنوں میں تعلیم پر توجہ نہیں دے پاتے لہذا ضرورت اس بات کی ہے کہ بچوں کو خالی معدہ اسکول نہ آنے دیں۔ دوسری بات اپنے اختلافات کا ذکر کبھی بھی اپنے بچوں

ترقی اور برکت عطا فرمائیں۔ آمین۔۔۔ پاکستان زندہ باد

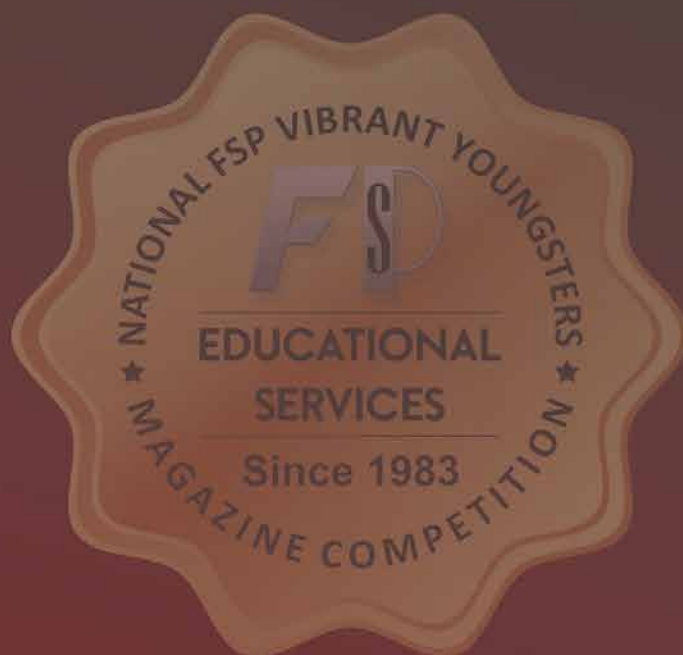
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
